Dear Patient,

Your provider has requested a benefit check for the medication of Xtandi/ Erleada /Zytiga/Eligard/Firmagon/Orgovyx. We will start the process by sending in an order to our in-house dispensary. We will work with your insurance to determine your responsibility for this medication. These are expensive medications and your responsibility can be costly. The Billing Staff are familiar with the cost of this medication and will work to help you obtain financial assistance if you are eligible. Depending on your type of insurance and financial income, you may qualify for assistance for your copay. They can also direct you to several patient foundations that are funded for patients with prostate cancer—if eligible, you may be able to receive funds for one year of medication. You may also qualify for assistance by the manufacturer for these medications.

Once SUA determines your cost, they will contact you to determine how to proceed. If you do not hear from SUA within 1 week from today's appointment, please contact our Practice Manager, Aileen Catone, at 412-372-6330 x 112. She will work with you to ensure your medication is ordered and all financial options are investigated.

We recommend that you contact the following foundations for funding as these foundations can be sporadic. This is a time consuming process! You must be persistent and check the availability daily. Please do not hesitate to contact Sue at 412-372-6330 x 116 with any funding questions.
